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• You don't need to take both! • Five sections • 36 is the highest score • Rewards good science students • Math questions include trigonometry concepts • West High students do better than

the average Montana & US student on the ACTs

• Broken into two categories, but each category is broken into smaller tests • 1600 is a perfect score • Rewards good English students with a strong vocabulary • West High students do better than the average Montana & US student on the SATs



#### Time!


