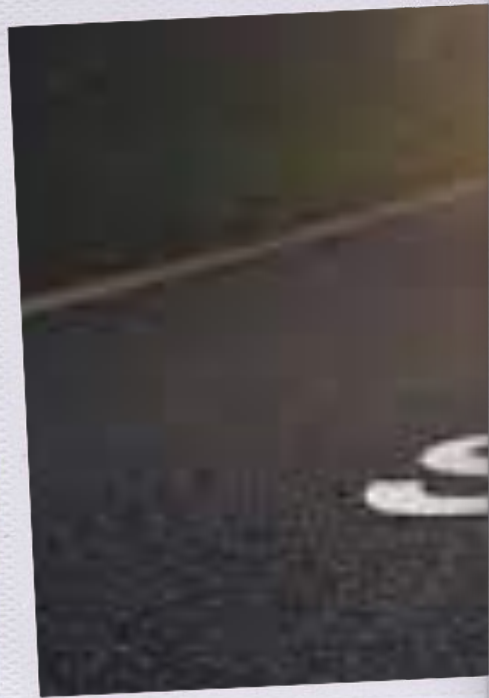

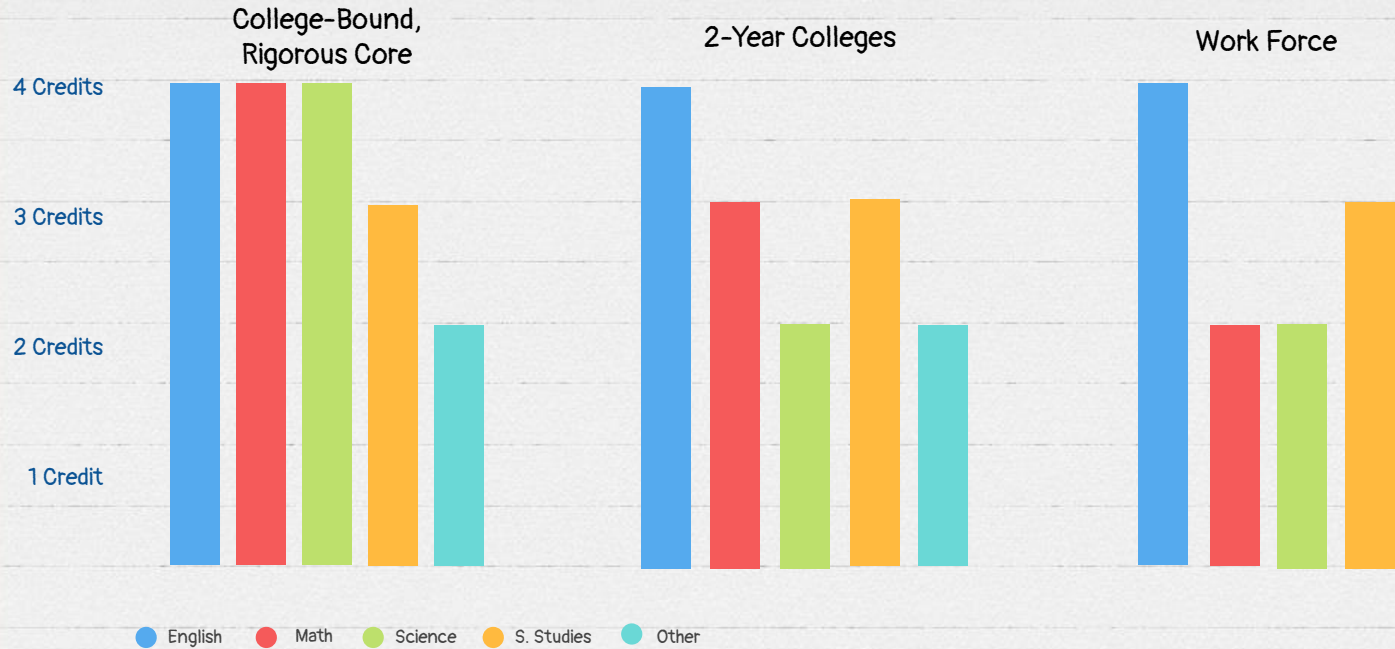

# Testing

## ACTs

- X Broken into five sections
- X Perfect score: 36
- X ACT rewards good science students
- X Math questions have trig concepts
- X You are not penalized for wrong answers
  - X Beneficial to fill in every bubble

## SATs

- X Broken into two categories
  - X Each category broken into smaller tests
- X Perfect score: 1600
- X SAT rewards good English students
- X You are not penalized for wrong answers
  - X Beneficial to fill in every bubble



**You don't need to take both!**

State ACT is on 4/12. Consider doing some test prep beforehand!

# Athletic Academic Eligibility

## NCAA, Div. I

- X Complete 16 Core Courses
- X Earn a **2.3** GPA in core courses
- X Take ACT or SAT & have testing company send scores to NCAA (9999)
- X Sliding scale

## NCAA, Div. II

- X Complete 16 Core Courses
- X Earn a **2.2** GPA in core courses
- X Take ACT or SAT & have testing company send scores to NCAA (9999)
- X Sliding scale

## NAIA

- X Meet two out of the following three requirements:
  1. Achieve a minimum 18 on the ACT or 860 on the SAT (critical reading and math)
  2. Achieve a minimum overall GPA of 2.0
  3. Graduate in the top half of your class
- X Take ACT or SAT & have testing company send scores to NAIA (9876)

*Both eligibility centers assume graduation!*
